## Kelloggsville Public Schools

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### Increase student achievement in all state-mandated...

*Status:* ACTIVE

*Statement:* Improve student achievement in the district on the state-mandated assessments (M-Step, SAT) by 25% by the end of the 25-26 school year by effectively using components of MTSS to provide both academic and non-academic support to students.

*Created Date:* 09/09/2022

*Target Completion Date:* 06/29/2026

*Data Story Name:* Increase the academic achievement for all students in Kelloggsville Public Schools in all core areas based on state standardized assessments.

*Initial Data Analysis:* The test data indicates that the students at Kelloggsville Public Schools have low levels of proficiency and growth on a variety of assessment measures. There are achievement gaps with our African American and EL student subgroups.

*Initial Initiative Inventory and Analysis:* Over the last couple of years there has been several initiatives started in Kelloggsville Public Schools:

New Curriculum- Using ESSER II and III funds, the district has purchased much needed curricular materials across the K-12 spectrum. Here is a brief summary- K-5 ELA- Bookworms, 6-12 ELA- Into Literature, 3-8 Math- Envision Math, 6-8 Science- science kits for hands-on learning, 9-12 Science- multiple resources.

PBIS or PSC- The goal of this program was to change the culture within our buildings, focusing on teaching and reteaching of expected behaviors as well as an emphasis to a more positive approach to discipline with fewer out of school suspensions. Our building counselors were selected to be the coaches and led the initiative in their building. There was some financial commitment from the district as each building had a budget to purchase supplies which included incentives for students making good choices. There was an extensive training for all staff which that allowed for a good first year. However, the pandemic made it difficult to continue the momentum. Based on TFI and DCA data, our goal for the 23-24 school year was to jump start this program.

Classroom PBIS (CHAMPS)- The rationale for this program was very similar to the school-wide PBIS/PSC initiative. A majority of our teachers were trained in the basics of CHAMPS before the pandemic. Once again, the pandemic had an impact on continuing the momentum. The district did offer training to new teachers before the 23-24 school year. There was also a refresher training for staff. Since not all teachers have been trained, it is difficult to mandate the implementation in every classroom. However, building administrators have made some commitment to looking for components of CHAMPS during classroom observations.

Restorative Practices- The goal of this program was to reduce the number of days of OSS for our students, as well as to teach students that their choices and behavior have an

impact on others. Almost all of our Counselors, Deans and Student Services personnel have been trained in the components of Restorative Practice. The district is currently participating in a research study through Michigan State University to determine the impact of the program. For the 2023-24 school year, the district has hired a part-time staff member from the Dispute Center of West Michigan. This staff member is responsible for conducting restorative practices circles with students and staff.

Mental Health Clinicians and an SEL Curriculum for students in grades K-8. The district has partnered with Family Outreach to provide 5 Mental Health Clinicians for the district. These staff members are part of our MTSS Framework and provide Tier III services for students that show the greatest need of support. 31n funds and general fund dollars are used to support this initiative. The district has also made a 5-year commitment to the Second Step SEL curriculum for students in grades K-8.

DEI Initiative- The district is working on making sure our schools provide equitable access for all students.

Emphasis on all students having access to grade level instruction.

Re-establishment of buiding school improvement teams.

*Gap Analysis:* Kelloggsville is underperforming compared to neighboring districts with similar demographics. We also have gaps between our African American Students when compared to all students. In addition, our EL subgroup is not making satisfactory academic progress.

*District Data Story Summary:* Kelloggsville Public Schools has a dedicated, devoted, caring staff that work hard to meet the needs of the students in their classrooms. However, there are many areas that need to be considered in order to change the current situation. Previous strategies and initiatives have not led to greater levels of student achievement and growth. This is due, in part, that our efforts have fluctuated over the years depending on the budget available to support programs and initiatives. We need to look critically in several key areas-

1. Staffing- KPS needs to maintain or increase staffing to support students that are at greatest risk. This includes all students that are below grade level academically, with a particular focus on our African-American and EL Student achievement.
2. Curriculum- We need to make sure that every staff member is teaching using evidence-based curricular materials. In addition, there needs to be vertical alignment between grades and departments to insure that all standards are taught.
3. Data Collection- The district needs to collect and analyze data from a variety of sources to develop a plan of action to address areas of improvement. This needs to be done at the district level through a District School Improvement Committee, as well as at the building level by smaller school improvement teams. This data needs to be shared with all staff on a regular basis.

**Summary:** EdTrust defines expanded learning time (ELT) as programs or strategies implemented to increase the amount of instruction and learning students experience. ELT strategies include afterschool, summer, and in-school programs. The evidence suggests that extended learning time programs, including extended school day (ESD), extended school year (ESY), and expanded learning opportunities (ELO) programs that provide academic services during out-of-school time hours, can be effective in improving a range of educational outcomes for students. Findings also suggest that extended learning time programs may be more advantageous for low-income, low-performing, ethnic minority or otherwise disadvantaged students.
